Julie's father spent 23 years running a special education program at Colorado State University and her mother was a superintendent in a Colorado school district. Seeing the impact her parents had on other's lives, Julie wanted a find her own way to make a difference. She decided to create a line of bracelets in ten distinct colors, each representing an individual cause. For each bracelet sold, Chavez for Charity will donate 25% of the gross profits to the designated charity. In the world of retail, this is a substantial donation, as the average donation to such causes is only 1-2%.



Bracelets are sold for \$10.95 each, or 3 for \$30. We are very excited to be a part of this great movement!

Tips & Tricks

Recipe Corner

Coffee Honey Glazed Ham

Ingredients:

7-8 lb ham

1 cup honey

1 cup Apple Butter (Spirit Valley available in store)

1/2 to 3/4 cup very strongly brewed Berres Brothers Coffee Breakfast Blend Coffee

1 teaspoon freshly ground cloves



Mix honey, apple butter and coffee. Rub ham with ground cloves. Place ham in roasting pan and pour half of coffee-honey sauce evenly over it. Reserve remaining sauce for basting and serving.

Bake on lower rack of 350 degree oven for 90 minutes or until meat thermometer reads 140 degrees. Baste with remaining sauce every 15 minutes.

Cover with foil for last 30-60 minutes to avoid excessive browning. Remove from oven and let rest in pan at room temperature for 30 minutes. Slice and transfer to serving platter. Heat remaining sauce and serve!
