Blueberry Buckle Beer Bread

Ingredients:

1 American Original Beer Bread Mix
1 12oz beer or any carbonated beverage
1 container fresh blueberries

Topping:

4 Tbsp butter
1/2 cup sugar
1/3 cup flour
1/2 tsp cinnamon

Glaze:

1 cup powdered sugar
4 Tbsp milk
2 tsp vanilla



Directions:

Add beer to bread mix. Fold in blueberries. Pour into a greased 10"x10" pan. Then mix topping with fork and sprinkle on bread dough. Bake at 350 degrees for 50 minutes. Mix glaze and pour over bread immediately out of the oven. Enjoy!
